(b) The test was conducted in the 3 years immediately before the day on	
which the application was made; and	
(c) The person achieved a score specified in the instrument.	
The current instrument states the following scores are required:	
• An IELTS test score of at least 8 for each of the 4 test components of	
speaking, reading, writing and listening; or	
• A score of at least "A" in each of the four components of an OET.	



XXX has achieved at least an IELTS score of '8' across all 4 components of speaking, reading, writing and listening in the IELTS examination.
