<p>Regulation 1.15EA defines superior English as</p> <p>A person has superior English if:</p> <p>(a) The person undertook a language test, specified by the Minister in an instrument in writing for this paragraph; and</p> <p>(b) The test was conducted in the 3 years immediately before the day on which the application was made; and</p> <p>(c) The person achieved a score specified in the instrument.</p> <p>The current instrument states the following scores are required:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An IELTS test score of at least 8 for each of the 4 test components of speaking, reading, writing and listening; or • A score of at least "A" in each of the four components of an OET. 	20
